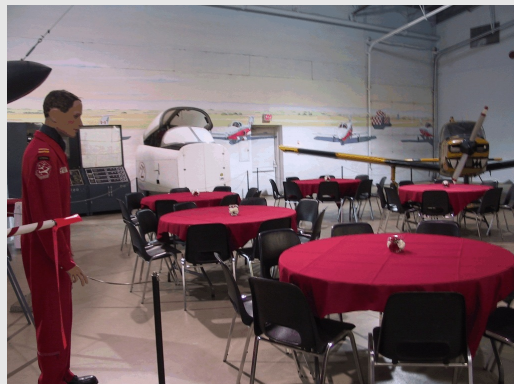

Facilities

Saskatchewan Hall

- Seats up to 190 depending on set-up
- large vacant room with concrete floors and ceilings; if requested additional time will be allowed for decorating.
- Costs Daytime
 - ½ day (8 am to 12 pm or portion of; 1pm to 5 pm or portion of) \$85.00*
 - 1 day (9 am to 5 pm or portion of) \$140.00*
- Costs Evening
 - 5 to midnight - \$275.00*
 - additional \$100 for every additional hour after midnight or any portion of

Education Room

- Seats up to 79 depending on set-up
- Costs Daytime
 - ½ day (8 am to 12 pm or portion of; 1 to 5 or portion of) \$85.00*

Security

The Museum requires one Security Guard for every 50 visitors. The cost is \$20.00/ hour. Any damages are the responsibility of the host and will be added to the invoice.

Museum Admission

If you are including a visit to the Museum as part of the experience for your guests you will be charged as follows. If paying individual ly guest will be charged the group rate

For groups exceeding 50 - Museum admission is \$2./ individual will be added to your invoice.

For groups under 50 - Museum admission is \$4/ individual will be added to your invoice.

Deposit

A deposit of 50% of basic charges is required at least two weeks before the event.

Banquet Bars

Cash Bar

Standard bar brand products

Individual guests purchase drinks from the Museum bar

Bartender \$18.00/ hour including 30 minutes before event and 30 minutes after event for a minimum of 3 hours. Ticket seller \$15.00/ hour including 30 minutes before event and 30 minutes after event for a minimum of 3 hours.

Liquor(30 ml)	\$6.00
House Wine by glass	\$6.00
Beer (Domestic)	\$6.00
Soft drinks/ Juice by the Glass	\$2.00

Subsidized Cash Bar.

Operates as a cash bar but the Host organization decides on the cost of the drinks and is invoiced for the difference.

Host Bar

The host pays for all the drinks consumed.

Bartender \$18.00/ hour including 30 minutes before event and 30 minutes after event for a minimum of 3 hours. Ticket seller \$15.00/ hour including 30 minutes before event and 30 minutes after event for a minimum of 3 hours.

Corkage Bar

The host obtains permit to bring their own liquor into the Museum. The host is responsible for finding a bar tender a ticket seller and all bar supplies. There is no corkage fee.
